A MIGHTY FORTRESS

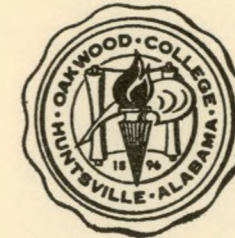
A mighty fortress is our God,
