Dear Sister Coulston,

Your kind letter has been received. As soon as I get a few moments time I will go down with Bro. Christian and see that everything is ordered in harmony with your wishes for the tomb stones.

We have word that Doctor and Mrs. Mourer are to arrive in Shanghai tomorrow and no doubt will be coming on to Peiping the first of the week. Inasmuch as the hospital has been without a physician for some two months now, the committee feels best for them to go on to Kalgan, locating there until some one can be secured to relieve them before they take up language study in the language school. In the mean time they will study with a private teacher.

Friends of Doctor Coulston's are putting a memorial stone in the center of the circle of the road in front of the hospital building. They have the cement base all in and we understand the stone will soon arrive there from Peiping.

We had a very interesting trip into Mongolia a few weeks ago. The new buildings for the station in Suiyuan have been completed and the Rodionoffs are happy to go into their new home. During the first month they took in over \$100.00 from their dispensary work. We held the dedication while there. It was very interesting to see those Mongolians coming from all directions across the plains to attend the opening services. We hope that many of them will accept this message. Peter is there helping out in the dispensary work.

Doctor Brines is staying with us while taking some special work in the P. U. M. C. Miss Johnson is also down here for a few days for dental work. There are three patients in the hospital and more to come in as soon as the new doctor arrives.
