Dear Doctor -

I suppose you have reached Washington safely. I have an item I think you may be interested in. A friend of mine residing in Healdsburg wrote me a few days ago that Sister White had spoken to the students and had made the following remarks: "Altho she did not mention the book by name, she stated publicly that God is not in the tree nor the leaf nor the flower, but simply gave these to man as evidences of His love. She stated positively that the students must not be taught that God is personally in the things of nature, or words to that effect. She also warned her hearers to beware of being deceived."
